## Installation

aiCharts library comes as a zipped package. File name contains version of library, for example: aiCharts.1.0.0.zip – file correspond to release with 1.0.0 version number.

After downloading and unpacking aiCharts package to desired location, following files should be exposed:

- doc folder (aiCharts class reference documentation, also available online)
- **Samples** folder (aiCharts usage samples)
- ArtfulBits Software License Agreement.pdf
- aiCharts User Guide.pdf
- aiCharts.jar
- **license.lic** (30-days trial license file). See licensing section for more info.

#### **Environment preparation**

In order to get things running, you will need following components installed and configured:


- Eclipse IDE (can be freely downloaded from eclipse website)
- BlackBerry JDE Plug-in (from <a href="http://na.blackberry.com/eng/developers/javaappdev/">http://na.blackberry.com/eng/developers/javaappdev/</a>)

### Getting started

Please follow instruction below to create and build application with aiCharts


1. Open Eclipse IDE and go to File -> Import -> Existing BlackBerry Projects into Workspace (or Existing Projects into Workspace)





- 2. Select MyChartApp project from samples directory and click finish
- 3. Notice that **licence.lic** file placed into sample's **src** directory. If you have already purchased aiCharts component, please replace this file with the one that sent to you. In most cases trial key gives sufficient time for learning all main things.
- 4. Create lib directory into project directory and copy aiCharts.jar into folder



5. Go to properties of MyChartApp sample, switch to **Java Build Path** and select **Libraries**. Add jar using "Add JARs..". Switch to Order and Export and mark aiCharts.jar

- 6. Now run the sample (Make sure that "Activate for BlackBerry" is checked)
- 7. The rest of aiCharts samples built according to described above techniques.
