What size are the NetAdvantage ICONS? Are all icons available in every size?

Each icon is designed to comes in the seven standard sizes expected by application designers. These image sizes include:

- 16x16
- 24x24
- 32x32
- 48x48
- 64x64
- 128x128
- 256x256

In what file formats are the NetAdvantage ICONS provided?

NetAdvantage ICONS are provided in the following, industry-standard file formats:

- 32-bit PNG (Portable Network Graphics)
- ICO (Windows Icon file format)

Each ICO includes all 7 files sizes.

How do the NetAdvantage ICONS handle color? What about transparency?

All icons are designed in 24-bit color, with an 8-bit alpha channel. Each icon includes a full alpha channel for easy compositing with your applications and layouts.

Can I use NetAdvantage ICONS on any platform?

Yes, you can use NetAdvantage ICONS across Windows Forms, ASP.NET, Silverlight®, Windows Presentation Foundation (WPF) and JavaServer[™] Faces applications. All icon files are designed to be compatible across many platforms.

Can I Redistribute the NetAdvantage ICONS?


