# **CASE STUDY**

Pragmatic Works Empowers Business Users from Nonprofit Medical Research Group to Perform Self-Service BI through On-Demand Training

### **Client Overview**

A large nonprofit medical research group needed a more efficient, all-encompassing, solution to arm business users with in order to effectively analyze data without IT involvement. As there was already a familiarity with Microsoft Excel within the various Business Analyst teams across the organization, Microsoft's Power BI was selected as the solution to perform instantaneous, ad-hoc analysis, significantly reducing reporting requests made to IT. They relied on Pragmatic Works' unique blend of classroom training, and On-Demand Training capabilities to sharpen the skills of it's over 800 users in order to fully leverage the new Self-Service BI platform.

#### **Business Needs**

The medical research group is a charitable, not-for-profit corporation with the mission to provide the highest quality, compassionate care at a reasonable cost through a physician-led team of diverse people working together in clinical practice, education and research in a unified multi-campus system. More than 400,000 patients a year come to their outpatient clinics and hospitals for care.


The group decided to adopt the Microsoft Business Intelligence (BI) technologies to meet the organizational data reporting needs currently served by a combination of BI reporting tools. There was an existing effort underway to categorize, prioritize and migrate from those reporting mechanisms as well as implement training on the Microsoft technologies.

The group's management team felt that their current tool was not sufficiently meeting the needs of their users and was not mature enough for their BI strategy. Users needed to be able to do self-service BI to customize reports and pin point specific data that they needed access to. The vast majority of reports that were being sent out were then being put into Excel by the different teams and carved up and combined with other data sources in order for the different departments to gain the information they truly utilized. This substantial waste of time and resources was taking place across multiple teams.

As with many organizations, IT was becoming a bottleneck due to the high demand for custom reports, which individual departments did not currently have the ability to create. IT was spending a lot of time creating these reports rather than being allowed to focus on the actual applications and developing solutions.

The internal team conceived an education plan for the strategic adoption of the new reporting technologies with a specific focus on Power Bl. They needed to incorporate the needs of both the business analyst and developer groups, the associated learning curves for the various technologies and long term plans for scaling these education efforts to meet current and anticipated demand for reporting. Previous attempts at group training had suffered some road bumps, including budget restraints, inability to monitor attendance and lack of post-course materials such as class recordings.

Additionally, there were issues with registrant's failing to attend trainings, which in turn lead to wasted funds as the classes were already paid for. The group also saw an issue with quality of trainers and course materials were often dated and did not include the latest technologies and the data used in the class was generic and inapplicable to the attendee's daily efforts.





## **Solution Deployed**

Pragmatic Works came on board to assist the medical research group's internal team with proper training on Microsoft technologies. The primary goal was to facilitate adoption of these tools by the business analyst and developer groups in anticipation of further implementation of Microsoft BI for collaboration and reporting, using the Power BI as the foundation. The immediate need was to provide expert training specifically on Self-Service BI tools within Power BI, SQL Server Reporting Services, Tabular, Power Pivot and SharePoint BI.

Pragmatic Works began the engagement by coming on the ground floor of Microsoft Business Intelligence for them: "One thing we've really seen as a value add, was that Pragmatic Works was in on our initial instructor lead training, they got a lay of the land and have really worked with us to understand our needs," said Jim, BI Analyst of Enterprise Information Management. This not only limited users by having to implement the new technologies they learned solely from memory, but it made onboarding new employees across departments very challenging as they had no materials to refer to. The class recordings were available on demand for any company employee that management granted access to. This not only enabled attendees to review class resources at will, but it also empowered the management team by putting them in control of who can be granted access to said materials rather than relying on an outside training company for this power.

#### **Benefits Delivered**

One of the main benefits to the group by using Pragmatic Works to fulfill their training needs was significant cost savings in multiple aspects. The Pragmatic Works corporate training packages are designed to be a reasonable option for companies needing to train large groups of people while adhering to a budget, "They want their bang for their buck and the training was very affordable," stated Jim. With multiple departments now trained to create advanced self-service solutions, the IT department is now free to spend their time creating applications and code rather than having to stop their regular work to create custom reports for other departments. The new training platform also enabled the group to ensure that funding was not being wasted due to several accountability checks they were able to access. "Prior to Pragmatic Works, people would cancel at the last minute and we would waste a lot of money on paying for a training that they didn't attend. With the Pragmatic Works platform, I can monitor attendance much closer and have the ability to add and remove people from classes very easily. This gives us a large cost savings." There are assessments after each module to ensure what students have just watched was retained. Managers can review test results through a reporting portal giving them insight into student performance. Once a course is completed a completion certificate is automatically generated for the student.

More accountability and flexibility within the platform also relieved stress from the management team: "The new training platform is light years better than what we had before. I can add people myself and it has made my life a lot easier. I can assign people to other classes in minutes and they can start their training immediately. Responsiveness is excellent. We would definitely utilize these trainings again and work with Pragmatic Works," said Jim. There is no delay in educational advancement, new employees can be rapidly on-boarded and existing employees can have immediate access to the training they need to improve their efforts.

The high quality of the Pragmatic Works training was another benefit that brought the large nonprofit medical research group a great return on investment, "I've said to our groups that our training has really brought us ROI on our investments, and it's measureable because when you have groups that take a day course and then within a week are making solutions that matters.
