End recording macro	Ctrl+X 'J'
Halt Slick-C macro prompting for a key with get_event()	Ctrl+Break
Halt Slick-C macro that is executing. Terminate infinite loops.	Ctrl+Alt+Shift+F2
Make and load current buffer	Ctrl+X Ctrl+L
Run last recorded macro	Ctrl+X 'E'
Start recording macro	Ctrl+X 'I'
Start/end macro recording	Ctrl+R
Terminate recording & run last recorded macro	Ctrl+T
